PowerPoint Presentation

PowerPoint - Your team's job is to prepare a presentation to educate your classmates about one of the body systems that makes up the human body. Your presentation must include the following requirements:

- Power point presentation should be between 10 – 15 minutes.

- 1. Name of the body system**
- 2. The purpose of the body systems.**
- 3. The structure and parts of the body system – (Anatomy and Physiology)**
 - a. List the parts of the body system
 - b. Show the structure of the system.
 - c. Explain the structure and parts of the body system work
- 4. The care of the system.** What are some personal behaviors you could do to care for the body system.
 - a. Daily activities
 - b. Medical check ups needed.
 - c. Other personal behaviors
 - d. Other information
- 5. The medical problems, diseases and or disorders that could occur with the body systems.**
 - a. What are the medical problems, diseases and or disorders that could occur?
 - b. What can you do to help correct the medical problems, diseases and or disorders?
- 6. Injuries**
 - a. How do these injuries occur?
 - b. What personal behaviors can you do to help reduce the possibilities of these injuries?
- 7. Area of medicine that studies the body systems.**
- 8. Information on personal behavior that affects the body system which is important for teenagers/young adults.**

Written Research Paper

REQUIREMENTS:

1. An approved topic about a disease or disorder that is associated with your body systems. You need to email me your research paper topic. tstanley@kunaschools.org. (see timeline for exact dates)
2. The BODY of the paper should be 3-5 double-spaced pages, typed pages using font size 12 and Times New Roman script. Your paper should have one-inch margins on each side. Two full pages and a partial third page will not meet the requirements for this paper.
3. Follow the format in the MLA HANDBOOK FOR WRITERS OF RESEARCH PAPERS. The library has several copies. You can also visit the MLA web site for help: www.mla.org
4. Minimum of 4 sources. Your Internet sources must be reliable and credible. You will need to locate the author's name of any web site information and be able to explain how you know you know the website is an expert in the particular field. Site your sources in MLA format.
